



# AEROSPACE JAM WITH THE MILWAUKEE BUCKS

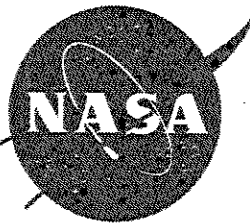

More than 150 of the state's top science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) students will engage with companies in Wisconsin's growing aerospace industry during the first-ever Aerospace Jam event this fall at the BMO Harris Bradley Center in Milwaukee.

The Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC), the Wisconsin Aerospace Partners and the NASA Wisconsin Space Grant Consortium are teaming up with the Milwaukee Bucks on the half-day event, which will take place prior to a Bucks game in October or November. The date and time will be announced after the NBA schedule is released.

During the Aerospace Jam, students from 29 academic institutions around the state will have the opportunity to meet with some of the more than 300 Wisconsin companies that serve the aerospace industry and representatives of state colleges and universities to learn more about career opportunities in the industry.

The event will include informational tables featuring colleges and aerospace companies, as well as presentations and panel discussions by industry leaders.
